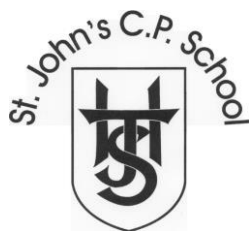


ST. JOHN'S COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL AND NURSERY
