If any orders placed after the final deadline of the 11th August, we can not guarantee delivery before school starts back on 5th September.

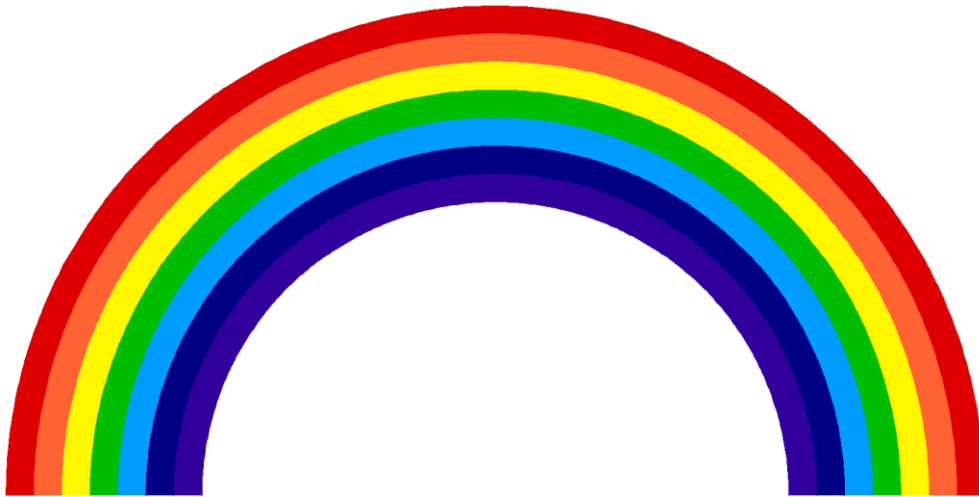
